**AWE Truck Studios Looking for Artists Interested in Bringing Creativity to Children**

Artists Working in Education, Inc., seeks dedicated lead artists and intern artists for the 12th summer of its Truck Studio, a free mobile art program for children in Milwaukee neighborhoods. Between June 28 and August 6, the four vans in AWE's *Truck Studio Fleet of Imagination* will travel to 19 park and playground sites for a week of free visual art activities for children ages 4-14. Each week is filled with open-ended art projects designed to spark children's imaginations by introducing them to basic elements and principles of art, historic and cultural art traditions, often using simple, everyday materials found at home.

Each van is stocked with art supplies and staffed by a Lead Teacher and two Interns/Assistants. AWE is looking for lead artists who are professional working artists with experience working with children and have a degree in fine art, art education, art therapy or a related field. AWE will also hire creative, dedicated interns/assistants who have completed at least some college level course work in art-related fields to fill intern/assistant positions.

Bilingual English and Spanish speakers and artists of color are strongly encouraged to apply. A required training session for all staff will take place on Friday evening, June 18 and all day
